#### RULES:

1. This is an **IBCA** Sanctioned event. All **IBCA** rules apply.

2. Quiet time is from Midnight to 6:00 am. At all times please be courteous to your fellow cooks by keeping music and other noise to a reasonable level.
3. Cook off takes place on the property of a TABC licensed bar.
4. Each team is permitted to bring 2 cases of beer with them upon check in/move in. All additional beer must be bought from the bar.
5. Please keep your cook area and surrounding area clean. We will provide someone to pick up bagged trash on Saturday. There will be a dumpster on site for your convenience.
6. Absolutely no selling of food or alcohol. Absolutely no serving alcohol to minors.
7. Set Up starts Friday at noon.
8. All teams and equipment must be off property by noon Sunday.
9. Head cook is responsible for the conduct of their team mates and guests. Persons exhibiting inappropriate behavior are subject to removal from property.
10. All cooks and team members must wear a face covering (i.e. medical face mask, bandana, neck gaiter, etc.) during the cooks' meeting, tray pick up, tray turn in and at awards. Any cook/team member who is not wearing a face covering will not be allowed to pick up or turn in trays and will be asked to leave the cooks' meeting until a face covering is worn. Not wearing a face covering is grounds for disqualification.
