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GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1) Registration fee is \$175 to include brisket, chicken, and pork spare ribs. Optional choices include \$25 for beans, \$25 for Cook's Choice-Meat, and \$25 for Cook's Choice-Dessert.
- 2) Check-in time starts Friday, June 11th at 7:30 am at the Sheriff's Posse Grounds located at 3826 Morningside Dr, New Braunfels, TX. Cook's Choice will be Friday, June 11th at 6:30 pm.
- 3) Head Cooks meeting is Saturday, June 12th at 7:30 am. We will go over all turn in times. Coffee and breakfast for Team Captains at 7:00 am.
- 4) Water and electricity is available at 45 sites within the grounds. Portable toilets will be available throughout the grounds. Generators can be used during the day and during "quiet time".
- 5) Lot sizes are 40'x40'; please see map of the grounds for layout. Cars/trucks must be parked within campsite area and not on side of roadway. All vehicles left on the side of the campsite roadway will be asked to be moved to the parking lot. Campsite roadways have to remain clear for emergency vehicles.
- 6) Since this is an event for Relay for Life; it is an opportunity to support and honor those who have survived, those who are still fighting, and to remember those who lost their battle – we invite you to bring pictures or mementos to share at your campsite.

The Payout will be 75% of the monies brought in. We will pay this over 1st through 5th place in each category. Trophies and certificates will be awarded as well as recognition trophies for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion. Grand and Reserve will be awarded a Free Entry into the 2022 Cook-Off.

Beans payout will be 60% of the monies brought in; with 1st place at 40%, 2nd place at 20%, 3rd through 5th will receive certificates.

Cook's Choice payout will be 60% of the monies brought in; with 1st place at 40%, 2nd place at 20%, 3rd through 5th will receive certificates.

Awards ceremony will be Saturday, June 12th at approximately 5:00 pm. This is under the pavilion, bring your lawn chairs and masks!

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OFFICIAL RULES

1. Each team will consist of one (1) head cook with a maximum of five (5) members per team. No more than 10 people allowed at site at any given time due to city ordinance.
2. Decisions of Committee Chairman and Judges are final
3. IBCA judging rules apply
4. No fundraiser activities or selling of food or products allowed without the consent of Cook-off
5. Meat and beans are subject to inspection and will not leave area after check in.
6. All Head Cooks must check in by 7:00 am Saturday and attend meeting where information and trays will be given.
7. No vehicles, trailers, motor homes, and other equipment may exceed the boundary of the contestant's space. You must maintain six foot (6') separation from neighbor's campsite or group.
8. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be sold or distributed to the general public.
9. All pets will need to be on leashes.
10. Loud noise is not permitted. No excessive or loud music is allowed. "QUIET TIME" will be from midnight to 6:00 am. Generators are allowed to run during this time.
11. No open pits are allowed. Fires may not be built on the grounds. Remember gas or electricity burners may be used to start fire only. **Every campsite MUST have a fire extinguisher!!**
12. No firearms or explosives (including fireworks) are allowed on location.
13. The BBQ Chairperson reserves the right to make additional rules or regulations as situations warrant. The Chairperson also reserves the right to disqualify any team that does not abide by the rules.
14. Every team must have hand sanitizer available, wear face masks when not at your campsite, and be aware of social distancing if you are not with your group.
