GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1) Registration fee is \$175 to include brisket, chicken, and pork spareribs. Optional choices include \$25 for beans, \$25 for Cook's Choice-Meat, and \$25 for Cook's Choice-Dessert.
- 2) Check-in time starts Friday, October 01 at 7:30 am Cook's Choice with both Cook's Choice at 6:30 pm.
- 3) Head Cooks meeting is Saturday, October 02 at 7:30 am. We will go over all turn in times. Coffee and breakfast tacos for Team Captains at 7:00 am.
- 4) Water and electricity are not available so bring your generators. Portable toilets will be available throughout the grounds.
- 5) Lot sizes are 30'x40'. Cars/trucks must be parked within campsite area and not on side of roadway. All vehicles left on the side of the campsite roadway will be asked to be moved to the parking lot. Campsite roadways are to remain clear for emergency vehicles.
- 6) All proceeds, after expenses, will go to the Scholarship fund of Guadalupe Ag & Livestock Fair Assoc.
- 7) Any team wanting to donate their extra cooked meat to the Fair Association for their booth at the Fair on Oct. 8th & 9th, please see Diana Tomlin. This would be so appreciated!

The Payout will be 50% of the monies brought in for 30 teams entered. We will pay this over 1st through 4th place in each category. Over 30 teams – this is subject to change for places paid. Trophies and certificates will be awarded as well as recognition trophies for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion. Grand and Reserve will be awarded a Free Entry into the 2022 Cook-Off.

Bean's payout will be 60% of the monies brought in; with 1st place at 40%, 2nd place at 20%, 3rd through 5th will receive certificates.

Cook's Choice payout will be 60% of the monies brought in; with 1st place at 40%, 2nd place at 20%, 3rd through 5th will receive certificates.

Awards ceremony will be Saturday, October 02nd at approximately 4:30 pm. This is under the large judging tent, bring your lawn chairs.

OFFICIAL RULES

1. Each team will consist of one (1) head cook with a maximum of five (5) members per team. No more than 10 people allowed at site at any given time due to city ordinance.
2. Decisions of Committee Chairman and Judges are final
3. IBCA judging rules apply – ***Meat Turn In Count Has Changed!*** **Chicken is one half now not 2, to include breast, wing, thigh and drumstick); Pork Spareribs is now 7 and Brisket is now 7 full slices**
4. No fundraiser activities or selling of food or products allowed without the consent of Cook-off
5. Meat and beans are subject to inspection and will not leave area after check in. This is at the discretion of the Promoter.
6. All Head Cooks must check in by 7:00 am Saturday and attend meeting where information and trays will be given.
7. No vehicles, trailers, motor homes, and other equipment may exceed the boundary of the contestant's space.
8. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be sold to by teams to attendees.
9. All pets will need to be on leashes and kept at your campsites.
10. Loud noise is not permitted. No excessive or loud music is allowed. "QUIET TIME" will be from midnight to 6:00 am. Generators are allowed to run during this time.
11. No open pits are allowed. Fires may not be built on the grounds. Remember gas or electricity burners may be used to start fire only. **Every campsite MUST have a fire extinguisher!!**
12. No firearms or explosives (including fireworks) are allowed on location.
13. The BBQ Chairperson reserves the right to make additional rules or regulations as situations warrant. The Chairperson also reserves the right to disqualify any team that does not abide by the rules.
14. Every team must have hand sanitizer available.
