#### Fantasy of Lights Cook off 2021 RULES AND REGULATIONS

December 3-4, 2021



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#### **General Rules**

1. The Fantasy of Lights BBQ Committee and Sealy Community Foundation reserve the right to expand or modify these rules and regulations. Decisions of the committee chairman and judges will be final.

2. The City of Sealy and the Sealy Community Foundation are not responsible for theft or damage to equipment or contestants.

3. The Chief Cook is responsible for the actions of its team members and guests. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification. No alcoholic beverages are to be served to anyone under 21 or sold to the public. All alcohol must remain in cook-off participants designated area.

4. Excessive Music will not be tolerated after midnight on Friday or Saturday night. Please be courteous to your neighbors.

5. Each team will be allowed to bring an ATV or golf cart for use specifically to access the entry turn-in point at the Hill Center. Operators are asked to be considerate of other participating teams while utilizing these vehicles.

6. A large dumpster will be placed at the entrance of the cook-off. All teams are responsible for disposing of their bags/garbage and maintaining the cleanliness of their spots.

7. No ATVs will be allowed in the main festival area or you will be escorted out by Sealy PD and asked to leave the premises. ATVs will be allowed outside of the main festival gates to turn in entries but traffic should be kept to a minimum and extreme caution used to and from the cook-off area for pedestrian traffic

#### Check-In

1. Contestants may start moving in after 3:00pm on Thursday, December 2nd.

2. Spaces will be grass.

3. NO electricity will be provided. All travel trailers and motor homes will have to operate off of a generator.

4. All contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies.

#### Cooking and Judging

1. No Meat Inspections will be performed.

2. Jackpot entries are Chef Choice (no dessert), Dessert, and Chili

- 3. Tray Pick Up will be 3:30 5:30pm in the Hill Center followed by Cooks Meeting
- 4. Chief Cooks meeting will be Friday night at 5:30pm at the Hill Center.

5. Fires must be wood or wood substance. No electric or gas fires are allowed. Holes or dug pits are not permitted. Heat shields must be provided if fires are capable of damaging contest area. Pellet cookers will be allowed.

6. Judging procedures – Only one (1) container of each category entered will be judged and on the blind system to ensure anonymity of contestants.

- 7. Entry fees \$175 for one meat or ALL meat categories
- 8. Friday Turn-In as follows:

Tray Pick Up 3:30 – 5: 30 pm Chief Cooks Meeting 5:30 pm Jackpot- Chef Choice (no dessert) 7:00 pm Jackpot – Dessert 8:00 pm

Saturday Turn-In as follows:

10:30 am Jackpot- Chili (no beans)

12:00 Chicken 1/2 fully jointed chicken half (to include breast, wing, thigh and drumstick.)

1:30 P.M. Pork spare ribs (7 individual pork spare ribs)

3:00 P.M. Brisket (7 Full Slices)

#### **Optional Jackpot Competitions**

- 1. All jackpots will be conducted on the blind judging system.
- 2. Jackpot Chef Choice and Dessert will be held on Friday, Dec. 3rd<sup>h</sup>. Chili competition will be held on Saturday, July 10th.
  - 3. All jackpot categories are OPTIONAL.
  - 4. Jackpot Chef Choice 7:00 pm, \$25 entry fee
  - 5. Jackpot Dessert 8:00pm, \$25 entry fee
  - 6. Jackpot Chili 10:30 am, \$25 entry fee Chili (no beans)

#### Move Out

1. All teams must be cleared of the contest site no later than noon on Sunday, December 5th.

2. Each team will be **responsible for cleanup of their site during the cook-off and prior to moving out.** There shall be no ashes, beans or trash left in their cooking areas. Again a roll-off trash dumpster will be provided at cook-off area for trash disposal.
