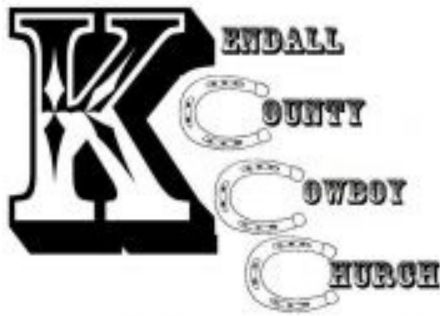

This is an International BBQ Cooker's Association sanctioned event and ALL IBCA rules are in effect and must be followed.

- **Meats:** ALL meats must be cooked on-site, no pre-cooking or marinating allowed. Inspection of meats will be conducted at check in. No meat will be allowed to leave the cook-off site after it has been inspected.
- **Entries Per Pit:** Following the IBCA guidelines only one (1) entry and (1) head cook on a given pit. Multiple entries in the same category by the same cook and/or multiple entries from the same piece of meat will not be allowed.
- **BBQ Pits:** The following pits will be permitted: Any commercial or homemade, trailered, or untrailered, pit or smoker normally used for competitive barbeque. A BBQ Pit may include gas or electricity for starting the combustion of wood or wood products but **NOT** to complete cooking. Pit should be of a permanent design that contains separate individual cooking chambers and heat sources (heat sources cannot be shared). Pellet cookers are allowed. Electric accessories such as spits, augers or force drafts are permitted. The use of heat lamps, proofing cabinets or any other electrical heating or holding device is prohibited. The process of Sous Vide, boiling or frying of competition meat is not allowed.
- **Categories:**
 - **Beef Brisket** Eight (8) full slices
 - **Pork Spareribs** Eight (8) individual cut ribs bone-in
 - **Chicken** One (1) 1/2 fully jointed chicken
 - **Beans**** One (1) 1/2 gallon
 - **Chef's Choice Dessert**** One (1) Dessert of your choice

*** additional categories will be \$50.00 per category. 75% payout for over 20 entries, 90% payout for under 20 entries.*

- **Sanitation** - Cooks are to prepare and cook in as sanitary manner as is possible including but not limited to using gloves, washing hands, and avoiding cross contamination.

- **Judging Trays:** All judging containers shall be clean and free of any markings. Marked containers may be disqualified at the Head Judge's discretion. Cooks are responsible for insuring that the containers they receive remain clean and undamaged.
 - **Judging Tray Contents:** The Head Judge will advise all cooks of the exact quantities and cuts of meats that will be placed in the judging trays. This will normally be accomplished at the cook's meeting. The Head Judge or designated representative will inspect all trays at the time of turn-in in order to assure compliance with the turn-in criteria. All garnishes and condiments are prohibited, as they do not reflect true quality of the cooked meats. **Meats may be cooked with sauces and/or other liquids, but once the cooking is complete, sauces, seasonings and/or liquids may not be added once put into the tray. There must be NO PUDDLING OR POOLING in the bottom of the tray. Additionally, CONTAINERS THAT CANNOT BE CLOSED WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT TURN-IN.**
- **Turn in Times:** A turn-in window of **ten (10) minutes** before and after the set turn-in time will be recognized. Judging trays received after that time will not be accepted for judging. Ten minutes and one second is considered after the set turn-in time.
 - Beans: 10:30 AM
 - Chef's Choice Dessert: 11:30 AM
 - Chicken: 12:00 PM
 - Pork Spare Ribs: 1:30 PM
 - Brisket 3:00 PM
- **Chief Cooks Meeting:** We will hold a chief cooks meeting Friday, September 9, 2022 at 7:00PM.
- There will be no electricity provided, you will need a generator. Check in is Friday, September 9, 2022. Check out time will be September 11, 2022. Spaces will be 30 x 30.
