El Campo Lost Lagoon General Rules:

- 1. El Campo Lost Lagoon reserves the right to expand or modify these rules and regulations. Decisions of El Campo Lost Lagoon management will be final.
- 2. All written or posted rules of the resort (in addition to these rules) will apply. It is each team members responsibility to read and understand the rules.
- 3. El Campo Lost Lagoon is not responsible for theft or damage to equipment or contestants.
- 4. The Chief Cook is responsible for the actions of its team members and guests. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification and expulsion from the resort grounds. No alcoholic beverages are to be served to anyone under 21 or sold to the public. All alcohol must remain in cook-off participants designated area. TABC regulations strictly prohibit any alcohol from being taken into the gated pool areas or any buildings. Private alcohol is only allowed at the RV sites. Alcohol is available for onsite purchase and consumption inside the bar areas.
- 5. Each team will be given 4 pool area entry wristbands for Friday and Saturday night per site. Up to 4 additional wristbands can be purchased per RV site for \$20 each.) Teams requiring more than 8 wristbands must purchase an additional site on the registration form. No additional guests will be allowed on resort grounds without a wristband. No day passes will be allowed. Registered cooking teams/family's and RV guests only.
- 6. Music will not be tolerated after 10PM on Friday or Saturday night. Excessive or profane music will not be allowed anytime! Please be courteous to your neighbors and observe all noise rules and regulations.
- 7. No pits or vehicles will be allowed on grassy areas unless prior direct approval by EL Campo Lost Lagoon is granted under each case. No parking trailers or vehicles in the roadways.
- 8. Each team will be allowed to bring a golf cart (no UTV's or ATV's) to access the entry turn-in point and navigate the grounds in designated areas. Operators must be 21 years old or older and are asked to be considerate of other participating teams while utilizing these vehicles. Private golf carts require a \$10 permit each and acceptance of resort golf cart rules obtained upon check in. Golf cart rental is \$90.00 a day and \$140.00 a day with a 2 day minimum and must be reserved ahead of time.
- 9. Dumpsters will be available. All teams are responsible for disposing of their bags/garbage daily and maintaining the cleanliness of their spots.
- 10. Each team will be responsible for cleanup of their site during the cook-off and prior to moving out. There shall be no ashes, left over beans or trash left in their cooking areas. Again, a trash dumpster will be provided at cook-off area for trash disposal.

- 11. No ashes are to be placed in the dumpsters or on the ground!!!!! Barrels or containers will be provided for ash disposal. No ground fires allowed!
- 12. Each team is responsible for preventing grease and dripping on the concrete. Please utilize a containment to prevent staining of concrete.
- 13. Children must be supervised at all times. No children under 12 will be allowed to enter the pool grounds without supervision.
- 14. All teams must be cleared from their site no later than 11AM on May 21th.
- 15. A reservation may be cancelled or changed more than 7 days of the arrival date. Then, a reservation voucher will be issued, minus a non-refundable \$25 rebooking fee. A reservation cancelled within 7 days of arrival is forfeited. Vouchers are redeemable for one calendar year from cancellation. Credits or refunds will not be issued for entry fees.
- 16. IBCA rules will apply to the cook off. Those rules can be found at

ABBREVIATED RULES FOR HAND OUTS

Eligibility:

- Cooks must be at least 7 years of age and no older than 17 on the date of the event.
- Cooks must be able to trim, season, cook and present their steaks entirely unassisted.
- Cooks must be able to supply their own:
 - Preparation table no larger than 4'
 - Seasonings and cooking utensils
 - Food Gloves
 - Grill
 - Charcoal

General Rules:

- 1. Cook entrants will be divided into two groups:
 - a. Junior Division: 7-12 years of age
 - b. Senior Division: 13-17 years of age
- 2. All cooking will be done in the designated cooking area.
- 3. Parents may help cooks set up their stations; however, they must leave the designated cooking area once their cook has picked their steaks.
- 4. Parents may re-enter the cooking area only after ALL contestants have turned in their steaks for judging.
- 5. No coaching or assistance of any kind will be permitted from outside the designated cooking area.
- 6. There will be one JPA Ambassador for every 2 cooks whenever possible.
- 7. Cooks may only address the JPA Ambassadors with questions.
- 8. JPA ambassadors will assist contestants with their fire, if needed, and will continue to monitor the fires throughout the event.
- 9. Cell Phones in the cooking area are prohibited.

I hereby certify that my child is fully capable of participating in this event and that my child is healthy and has no physical or mental disabilities or infirmities that would restrict full participation in this event.


