2024 BAR-B-Q COOK-OFF
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Introduction:

- a. The contest will be limited to the space available. Cooking spots will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- b. Electrical is **extremely** limited and on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- c. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies. The Bar-B-Q management will provide space only.
- d. V.F.W. Post 8905, the Bar-B-Q committee, and any of their representatives will not be held responsible for any theft, damage, or injury.
- e. The Bar-B-Q Committee reserves the right to make additional regulations as the situation warrants.
- f. Decisions of the Bar-B-Q Committee and judges will be final.
- g. This event is sanctioned by the International Barbeque Cookers Association (IBCA). All IBCA rules and regulations must be followed. Violation of IBCA rules will be grounds for immediate disqualification. Visit www.ibcabbq.org for more information.

2. Administration

- a. Large Rig Contestants can check-in and set up their space after Thursday 10:00 AM but **must** be in place by Friday morning 11:00 AM. Checking in after this time will require prior approval of the BAR-B-Q Committee.
- b. The Bar-B-Q Team is responsible for keeping their area clean and assisting with garbage disposal. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- c. The Chief Cook will be held responsible for their team and guests' conduct. Beer and soft drinks will be available to the public in the Canteen.
- d. State Law requires 21 years of age to consume alcoholic beverages.
- e. Each team will have a committee member assigned to assist with any questions.
- f. Dogs are allowed but must be friendly, **kept in the team area**, and on a leash.
- g. **Vehicles parking in front or blocking gate will be crushed and towed at the owner's expense.**
- h. No mules, golf carts, bicycles, water balloons, slingshots, firearms, etc., will be allowed in the contest area for safety reasons.

- i. For Safety Reasons: Gate will be closed at 9:00 p.m. on Friday and remain closed until after the awards ceremony.
- j. Outside, beer or wine is not allowed. Teams may BYOB and purchase set-ups from the Canteen.
- k. All contestants and guests must wear shirts and footwear on-premises.
- l. The Head Cooks meeting will be held **at 6:00 p.m. on Friday.**
- m. All winners will be announced, and awards will be presented after the completion of Brisket Judging. 5:00 PM Auction and Awards Ceremony.
- n. Contestants must have their equipment out of the cook-off area by noon Sunday.

3. Cooking

- a. **Brisket**- Eight (8) full slices. Blocking Brisket ends is allowed. The fat cap may be trimmed or cut away before the slices are placed into the tray. Brisket must be placed in the tray parallel to the hinge. May not be salted, seasoned, or marinated before the head cooks meeting on Friday. Each team may have a MAXIMUM of two briskets.
- b. **Pork Spareribs**- Eight (8) individual cut ribs (bone-in) (St. Louis Cut acceptable). Ribs must be placed in a tray MEAT side up, lying parallel to the hinge. Baby back or Country Style Ribs are not permitted.
- c. **Chicken**- One (1) ½ fully jointed chicken MEAT side up (to include breast, wing, thigh, and drumstick). SKIN ON (No Cornish Game Hens).
- d. **Open** - Open category will be MEAT ONLY (NO DESSERTS).
- e. **Beans**- Pinto beans only. Nothing in the beans is larger than a bean.

4. Entry Fees and Prizes

- a. **Brisket, Chicken, and Ribs. \$200, plus a live auction item valued at \$50 or more. Live auction item due at check-in.**
- b. **Open and Beans: \$25 each.** These events are optional. The first-place winner will receive 80% of the entry fees.
- c. Cash prizes are based on the number of paid entries in each event. 80% of the money collected will be prize money for first, second, and third place in ribs, chicken, and brisket.
- d. **All entry fees must be received no later than one week before the event or designated spot will be reassigned to next on waiting list.**
- e. Entry forms can be dropped off in person at the Post Canteen between the hours of noon and midnight, Monday through Saturday, or from noon till 6 p.m. on Sunday, **OR ONLINE AT WWW.VFW8905.ORG**
