ALL IBCA AND KENNEDALE BARBECUE SHOWDOWN RULES APPLY

- 1. The BBQ competition consists of brisket, ribs, and chicken (\$225 entry fee). In addition, the BBQ contestants can submit their best pot of beans for an additional \$25 entry fee.
- 2. The contest will be limited to the space available. Cooking spots will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 3. Check-in time begins at 2pm on Friday. ALL COOKS MUST BE CHECKED IN BY 6:00 AM SATURDAY.
- 4. Mandatory Meat will be inspected before you may begin seasoning.
- 5. UTILITIES Water is available at the cook-off site, there is no electricity for your use.
- 6. Only one (1) team per pit.
- 7. Teams will consist of a Head Cook and up to 4 team members.
- 8. Any and all meats entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event. Pre-cooking, marinating, etc., will not be allowed prior to the start of the cook-off as defined by the cook-off promoter. Beans (dry pinto) must be cooked onsite.
- Fires must be wood or charcoal. Pit may include gas or electricity to start the natural substances, but may not be used in any part of the cooking process. Pits/Grills will be inspected upon arrival. Holes or open pits are not permitted. Fires may not be built on the ground. Each team MUST bring a fire extinguisher.
- 10. IBCA trays will be handed out at the Head Cook meeting at 6:00pm Friday. (HEAD COOKS MUST ATTEND)
- 11. It is the responsibility of the contestant to see that the contest area is kept clean and that the area is cleaned and policed following the contest. All fires must be put out, concrete blocks and other building materials or props hauled away, and all equipment removed from the site.
- 12. Open consumption of alcohol is prohibited.
- 13. The cooking area allotted is 30x40 feet. Once the cookers are setup, your vehicles will need to be moved to the designated parking area.
- 14. RV spots are available onsite at a nearby location. There are no hookups, your RV must be selfcontained.
- 15. Golf carts are allowed.
- 16. *IBCA* judging rules will apply.
- 17. Promoter and cook-off officials will not be held responsible for accidents, theft, or any mishaps.
- 18. Absolutely no firearms or explosives are allowed.
- Music should be used in moderation during the entire cook-off and must be turned off from 10pm Friday night until 8am Saturday morning.
- 20. Kennedale Barbeque Showdown and IBCA reserves the right to make additional regulations as situations warrant. Decisions of Committee and Judges are FINAL.
